

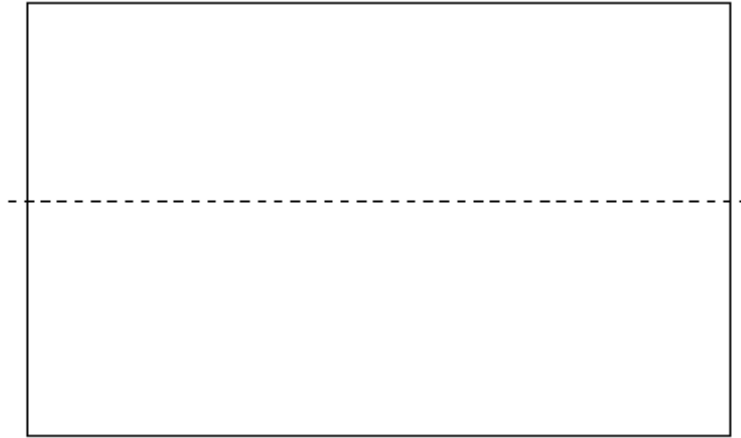
How To Make Snuggle Bag

(Green Cheek Conure Size)

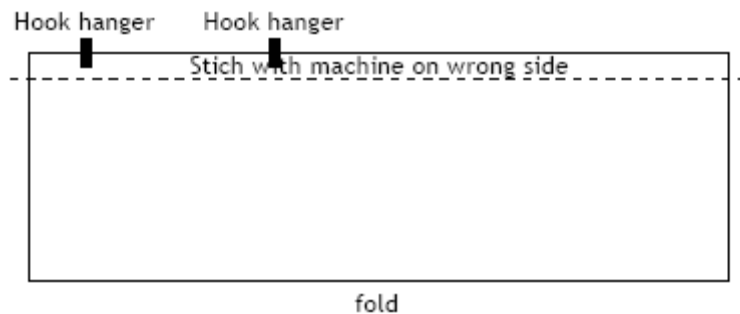
Buy ½ yard of your favorite fleece (you can usually get it on clearance at Wal-Mart for like 75 cents). Wash your fabric before you start, you don't want to make it the right size for your bird just to have it shrink later. You will also need two hooks (I stole them off of old toys).

Cut your fabric, one piece should be 20 inches by 14 inches, and two small pieces (your hook hangers) 4 in long by 1 cm wide.

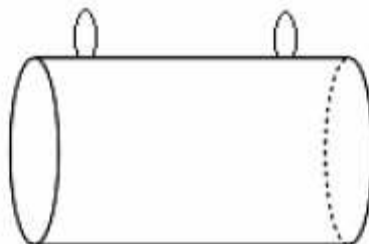
Fold it in half, right sides together



Fold hook hangers in half and place between the two layers at marks shown with open ends sticking out. Stitch open long end about ½ in from edge



Roll wrong sides together (like rolling up your shirt sleeve) so that hook hangers are on outside top of sleeve and you have right side showing on the outside and the inside.



Insert a small rectangular piece of cardboard in between the two layers of material at the bottom to reinforce the “floor” and make a sturdy place for your GCC to stand. This will make your sleeve into a triangular shape. Sew around the outside edges to keep the cardboard from falling out.
